# **ROLLER DERBY RUNDOWN**

## HISTORY

In the late 1930s roller skaters competed in marathon-like races on a raised track. Over the course of these races there was a progression to a physical competition emphasizing skater collisions and falls. This evolved into the foundation of the team sport that still exists today: two teams of five skaters who score points by passing members of the opposing team. In the 1980s and 1990s, roller derby was a pro-wrestling style spectacle including staged action and storylines.

In the early 2000s, modern roller derby got its start in Austin, Texas. New leagues formed as businesses run by the athletes themselves. The flat track version of the sport spread like wildfire in subsequent years. By 2010, there were more than 450 flat track roller derby leagues worldwide. Modern roller derby is a sport with athletes who train hard and play harder. Skaters are unpaid and do it for the love of the game. Roller derby is a full contact sport with an extensive ruleset.

## **ABOUT MN ROLLER DERBY**

Minnesota Roller Derby is a skaterowned, flat-track roller derby league founded in August 2004 by the Donnelly sisters. Our league has grown from six original members to a current roster of 80 skaters, as well as officials, coaches, and many volunteers. All league members are unpaid amateurs and belong to the Women's Flat Track Derby Association (WFTDA).

We have four home teams who battle every season to win the coveted Golden Skate trophy. Beyond our four home teams, Minnesota Roller Derby All-Stars skate against the best in the world, competing in the WFTDA Championships in 2006, 2010-2012, and 2014-2017.

We are dedicated to our local communities and we invest our time, effort, and a portion of our event proceeds to local, and sometimes national, charities. Minnesota Roller Derby has raised over \$80,000 om support of more than 40 charities.

The mission of the Women's Flat Track Derby Association is to govern and promote the sport of flat track roller derby and revolutionize the role of women in sports through the collective voice of its member leagues around the world. ## PLAYER POSITIONS

#### JAMMER

The Jammer wears a star on their helmet and has to score points by getting through the pack, a collection of four players fro m each team. A point is scored for each opposing skater who is legally passed.

#### PIVOT BLOCKER

The Pivot is recognizable by a single stripe on their helmet. Prior to the start of a jam, Pivots may line up on the Pivot Line. In certain circumstances during a jam, a Pivot may take over the position of Jammer.

#### **BLOCKERS**

Blockers are often playing offense and defense at the same time. A Blocker's job is to help their Jammer get through the pack and prevent the opposing team's Jammer from scoring points. These duties are performed by executing a variety of strategies, including legal hits and setting up defensive walls.


## GAME PLAY

#### STRUCTURF

Bouts consist of two teams playing in two 25 or 30 minute periods. Periods are separated into jams which can last up to and one Pivot from each team line up together to form a pack. One Jammer from each team lines up on the Jammer Line. When the whistle blows the Jammers fight their way through the pack. The first Jammer who legally exits the pack is declared Lead Jammer. This Jammer has the strategic advantage of being able to end the jam, possibly before the two minute duration has expired.

#### SCORING POINTS

Upon lapping and re-entering the pack, Jammers score one point for each skater of the opposing team that they pass in-bounds. During a scoring pass, a Jammer also earns points for opposing team skaters in the penalty box.



# **REFEREE HAND SIGNALS**



## LEAD JAMMER

The first jammer to pass all of the blockers legally and in-bounds. The Lead Jammer may call off the jam at any time by repeatedly putting their hands on their hips.

## **PACK IS HERE**

The pack is the largest group of blockers from both teams within ten feet of one another. Referees often signal where the legal pack is defined in order to clarify where skaters may engage each other.



## **CUTTING THE TRACK**

Bettering your position on the track from out-of-bounds. Skaters must pass one another only while legally in-bounds.



### LOW BLOCK

Contact with or to the legs, causing an opponent to stumble, trip, or fall.



### **BACK BLOCK**

Contact to an opponent's back-side, causing them to stumble, trip, or fall.



### FOREARM

Jabbing, hooking, or pushing an opponent with a skater's elbow or forearm.
